SHORT DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT:

e-COLORSS will prepare the ground for an improved European artillery system with a 155 mm cannon and rocket launcher mounted on a hybrid truck platform.

The project "European Common Long Range indirect fire Support System" (e-COLORSS) proposes a significant step forward for European long-range artillery through a 155 mm cannon and a European rocket launcher. The vehicle will be based on a hybrid truck mounted platform, ensuring a very fast ammunition and charges resupply, and an interoperable, robust and secured communication system.
